SECTION V

LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT CAUCUSES

- C. **Allocation of Delegates.** Delegates and alternates to the state convention shall be allocated in proportion to the votes cast for Barack Obama and Christine Gregoire in the 2008 general election.

SECTION VII

STATE CONVENTIONS

- B. **Number of Delegates.** There will be 1,200 elected delegates and 600 elected alternates to the State Convention. Any county with less than ten delegates may send up to 10 people, with fractional votes, to the convention. In addition to the elected delegates, the following shall be automatic delegates to the State Convention: all **state committee** members, county chairs, congressional district chairs, legislative district chairs, Democratic Members of Congress from Washington State, Democratic Statewide Elected Officials, and Democratic State Senators and Representatives.
