When elected, how would you make sure that you and your fellow elected officials continue to be accessible to constituents and their concerns and open to public input?

I am retired, and so I'm always available. I personally doorbell, every year, giving out a report card of what's happening in the City. We also have neighborhood meetings.

Why should the 25<sup>th</sup> Legislative District Democrats support you over any other candidates running for this position?

I stand on my record. Our Council has a great record, and most importantly WE work together. This hasn't always been true. We had 8 years of bickering before 2016/2017. Councils have a very fragile balance. Ability to work with others is vital. My experience and Seniority on my Pierce County Committees is also essential for funding.

Neither of my opponents has experience at this level. I have strong relationships with my peers. Neither opposing candidate would advance all Democratic Party beliefs. On the issue of the Homeless there would be extreme viewpoints. I believe that my moderate position wins consensus and this is vital for successful outcomes. I simply ask for fair consideration....Thankyou.

What strategies would you propose to solve the homelessness crisis?

We are not going to *solve* the crises! But we can improve various segments.

I am on the Pierce County 2060 (affordable housing), the 2163 (homelessness) committees, and the Citizens Advisory Board for Block Grants.

We must work with State and County on all aspects of this problem.

I am convening a local Mayor's group at this time.

Youths need shelter and job training. This should be a priority.

Mental Health funding is vital. The 1/10 of 1% was a lost opportunity. The Pierce County supplemental budget needs to happen. The State budget needs to increase funding.

Addiction treatment availability is lacking.

Affordable housing should be a priority for prevention, in particular for families and seniors.

At the same time impacts on the general population need to be addressed. This can happen by proper location of services. Obviously this is a complicated subject, and I have only touched on it. There are many excellent ideas out there. The secret is for ALL jurisdictions to do their part and work together.

What would you do to encourage economic development in your city?

We already are, by our work on providing data for "determination of non-significance" to builders. We are also doing two studies on several specific sites. Actually our problem isn't encouragement, it is facilitation. We are trying to add development service staff, but are struggling to find personnel to hire. Our permitting process is backed up.

What would you do to address the transportation/transit challenges facing your city?

We just passed an "active transportation plan."

We also lobbied hard for the Gateway project. Now we have to negotiate funding match money.

We support a new parking garage downtown, and Transit Orientated development.

Unfortunately we are falling behind on road capacity projects.

Are there any additional comments you would like to share with the 25<sup>th</sup> Legislative District Democrats?

I listed myself as an independent, because this is a non-partisan race, and my beliefs are moderate. I have always supported Democrats on the National scene and for Governor. Locally my filter is "Who's best for Puyallup?"

On all the social issues I align with the Democratic platform. I support the A.H.C.A and the past administration in general. I was a Union Business Agent, and now am a retired Union electrician. I would have voted for Bernie Sanders over Trump! I don't have a problem increasing taxes or utilities, but only when necessary. (Feel free to check my voting record). I am however, determined to reduce our City debt even more. This is the path to sustainable neighborhood street rebuilding. So I am a fiscal conservative, and think long term when it comes to financial planning. I also hunt down grants and believe that Puyallup is part of a region, and not just a small city. I am on six regional committees, because I believe in collaboration.
