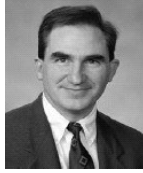

FROM THE CHAIR

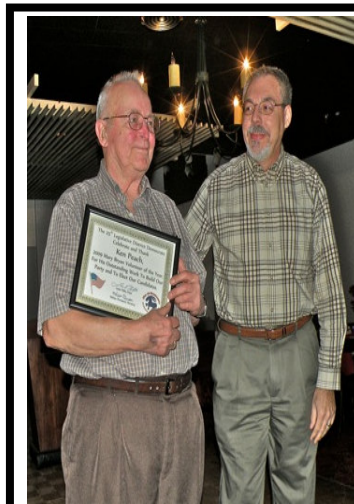

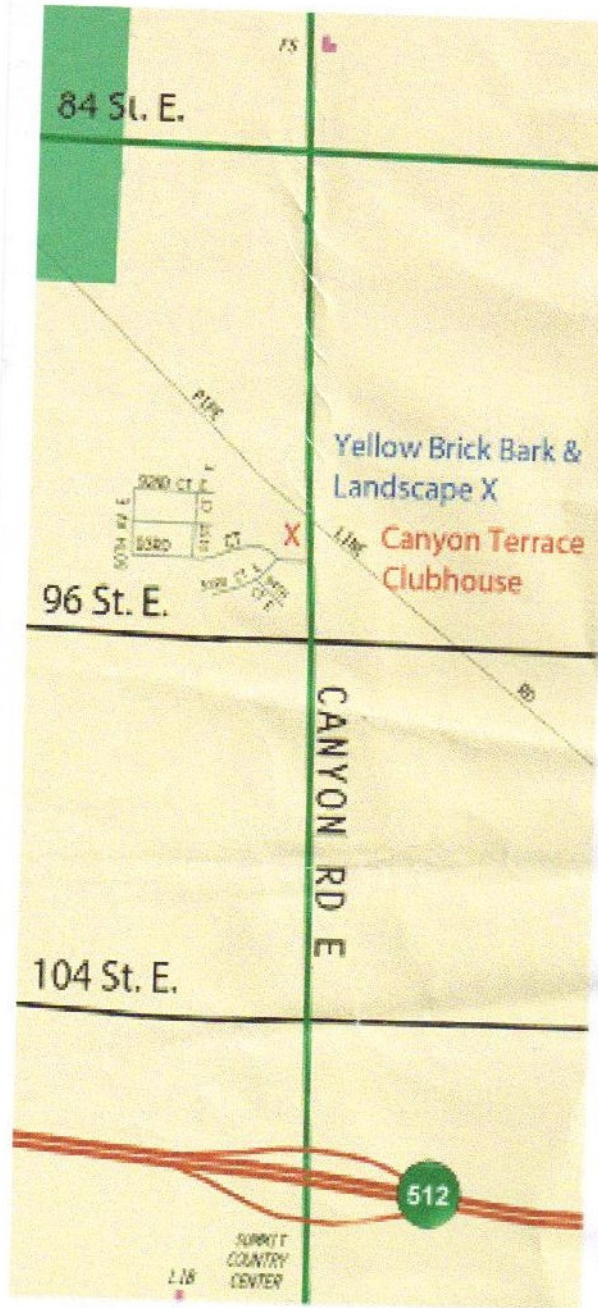
Representative Dawn Morrell was honored with a heartfelt speech given by Senator Kastama and presented with flowers. Senator Kastama remembered when Dawn was first on the floor of the legislature and people were asking, "who is this Dawn Morrell?" because of her unabashed passion for the members of her District. He said her judgment was always respected, and for good reason. She will be missed.

Kastama said he isn't afraid to tell folks about the status of our State and the budget cuts we will be facing, even though that is not a popular stance. The State can no longer rely on the Federal Government to get us out of this financial crises. "The crises has now become normal," he added.

Kastama will work to be sure Washington is an innovative State and his focus will be in the education arena. Speaking to building an infrastructure for the future, Kastama said his second priority will be to get an on-line, fully accredited University up and running where tuition will run about \$2800 every six months. In this fashion, more Washington state residents will have access to a college education.

Representative Morrell spoke to our group about the election and thanked all the volunteers who were there on a daily basis, knocking on doors, waving signs and writing checks to her campaign. The loss of Morrell in the House will be felt by us all in the next two years.
