Chair's Message

Once again we have had an election with a mixed bag of results. This mixed bag is due largely to low participation among voters, and as everyone should know by now, low voter turnout equals bad news for those that hold Democratic values. As of Thursday November 19th the Pierce County Auditor's unofficial results showed a pitiful 33.99% of registered Pierce County voters cast their ballots in this November's election.

The people of Fife will once again be represented by Bryan Yambe. Because of Bryan's good work on the council he was re-elected by a very large margin even though lots of money and in-kind contributions were used in an attempt to unseat him. The Puyallup City Council will have two new members, Robin Farris and Dean Johnson, who received a lot of help from a few members of the 25th LD Democrats. Councilman John Palmer will be returning to the council as well. Three out of four of the 25th LD Democrats' preferred candidates won their races for Puyallup City Council. Even though Robin Ordonez and his team worked seven days a week, he was unable to unseat his opponent who received a massive amount of help from the local Republican machine.

Both of our endorsed candidates for the Franklin Pierce School Board will sit on the board the next four years. Mary Sherman ran unopposed. Melanie Morgan won her contested race. It is notable that no candidate for the Puyallup School Board responded to our invitation for an endorsement request.

In the races for the Pierce County Charter Review Commission 1 out of 4 of our endorsed candidates won. Carolyn Merrival will return to the commission that she sat on 10 years ago. Eric Herde and Laura Groves did not win seats on the commission. Ken Blair didn't make it to the general election. The composition of the Charter Review Commission may prove to upset the fairness of Pierce County government. Sadly with a few more votes in each precinct we could have had three of our endorsed candidates on the commission and tipped the balance of the commission to the Democrats' favor for all of Pierce County. When I say a few more votes per precinct I mean a very few – 4 votes in one race and 13 in the other. We are not far from winning races like these; we just need enough members of the 25th LD Democrats to decide that it is important enough to give a couple hours a week during election season.
