Message

The Washington State Democratic Presidential Precinct Caucuses were held Saturday March 26th and I hope this is not news to anyone reading this. There was a good turnout at the seven locations where the 25th LD Democrats held caucuses. The caucus turnout for the 25th LD (as it is presently comprised after the 2010 census and redistricting) was over 150% of the turnout in 2008, the last year in which there was not an incumbent president running for re-election. I think anyone who went to the caucuses would say they ran pretty smooth with no major problems. Caucus attendees made enough contributions to cover about two-thirds of the precinct and Legislative District Caucus expenses that will be incurred by the 25th LD Democrats. The 25th LD Caucus Committee will appreciate any additional donations to help cover the rest of our caucus costs.

I wanted to acknowledge the Fife, Franklin Pierce, and Puyallup school districts for allowing the Democrats and earlier this year the Republicans to hold their caucuses in school buildings free of room rental fees. We paid only for custodial wages for the overtime to have staff at these Saturday events.

The caucus results were very similar at all seven locations in which the 25th LD held the precinct caucuses. Senator Sanders received between 68.9% (Emerald Ridge High School location) and 82.4% (Midland Elementary School location) of elected delegates. Overall throughout the 25th LD Bernie Sanders received 74.8% of the delegates and Hillary Clinton received 25.2% of the delegates.

The delegates that were elected at the precinct caucuses will go to the Democratic Legislative District Caucuses at Franklin Pierce High School on Sunday April 17th. The caucuses start at 1:00pm. Separate caucuses are held for delegates from the two Congressional Districts that lay within the 25th Legislative District, the 8th and 10th Congressional Districts. It is important that Delegate Alternates also show up. With the 441 delegates that were elected from the precinct caucuses there will be some delegates that can't make it on April 17th. If there are not alternates to step in to cast votes the presidential candidates will lose votes and it could change the distribution of delegates eventually awarded to the candidates. The precinct caucuses are not the final step in the delegate allocation process. If you are a precinct caucus delegate make sure you come to the LD Caucus to support your candidate.
