Changes to the Membership Dues Structure

At the November 2, 2009 Executive Board Meeting a motion was seconded and carried to make yearly membership dues cover each calendar year; beginning January 1 and continuing through December 31. This means that all current members' dues will pay them for one calendar year beginning January 1 through December 31. The 25th Legislative District would appreciate dues to be paid by the end of January to keep individuals in good standing; i.e. electronic newsletter receipt, voting privileges, etc.

When new members join, if they join in months later than January, they will receive a prorated rate for the portion of the year that remains on the calendar. For example, if a new member joins the organization in June and chooses to pay Rainier level dues, they're prorated dues rate would be \$14.00, and their membership would be active through December 31 of that same calendar year. New members should consult with the Treasurer or Membership Chair to arrange a prorated dues receipt.

Changes to Distribution of Newsletter

It is the strong desire of the organization to continue to distribute and provide a monthly newsletter to our members. Rising costs of production, printing and postage have made it difficult to continue to produce a mailed copy to each member. Many of our members have requested that their newsletter be emailed to them each month and this has helped the organization greatly. Beginning with the January 2010 newsletter all copies of the 25th Legislative District Democrats newsletter will be sent via email. Please update your email address now with the Membership Chair to ensure that you don't miss a copy!

Realizing that not everyone has an email address, or that some simply prefer to have the newsletter in hand to read, the organization is offering two opinions to serve you:

1. 25 hard copies of the previous month's newsletter will be provided for at each monthly meeting.
2. Supplemental newsletter membership dues will be offered. Again, due to the cost of production, printing and postage the organization must look to supplementation to produce the newsletter. If you would like to continue receiving your newsletter in the mail each month, you may opt to pay the additional newsletter dues. Newsletter dues will be \$10 per year. This amount is in addition to your membership dues.

NOVEMBER MEETING SPEAKER PAT McCARTHY



At our November meeting we were lucky enough to snag Pierce County Executive, Pat McCarthy as our guest speaker. As McCarthy addressed our group she said the first few months at her new job as Pierce County Executive she felt, “like I was drinking water out of a fire hose,” but that “my team has their mojo together now.”

The new Executive has faced a daunting task taking over the position during the huge downturn in the economy, but she has persevered. McCarthy said as Democrats, our challenge is now and these are difficult times, adding “the recession is a challenge for anyone in government.”

McCarthy is working closely with all cities in Pierce County to try to meet their needs and concerns, including our area and the flooding issues we are facing. She said she fully realizes the impact that the floods had on our area and is working with residents and engaging all parties to be sure that if a flood exists in the future, the roads will remain open and flooding will be kept to a minimum.

McCarthy said our state received 500 Million in stimulus money for transportation and she credited all the legislators that got “on board” as key in obtaining those funds. “It is never about just one person,” said McCarthy, “it is about a collective group.”
